The Human Developmental Genetics Unit at the Institut Pasteur, Paris is committed to a highly successful European Union funded project that is coordinated by Pr Olaf Hiort. This EuroDSD project uses state of the art molecular and biochemical approaches to understand the mechanisms underlying several rare diseases. The closure of the University of Lübeck would have profound consequences for the national and international members of the consortium and also for the longer-term prospects of this important international collaboration.

The University of Lübeck is a leading German and European centre of biomedical clinical and research excellence and I cannot believe that a shortsighted decision could be taken for its closure.
